

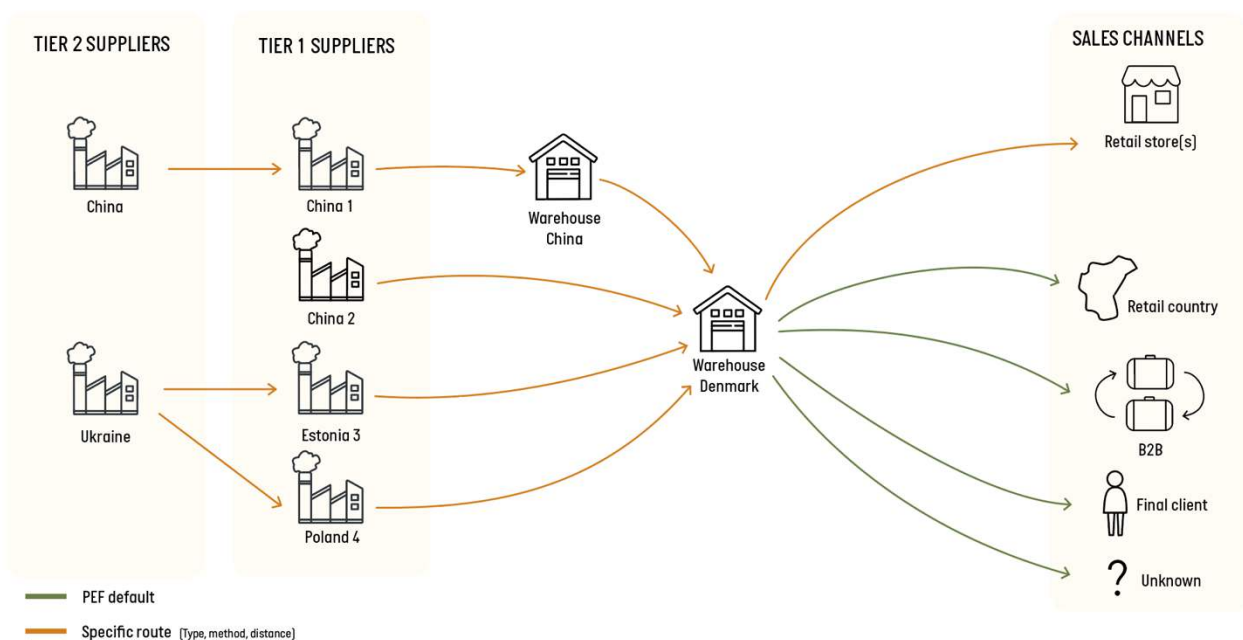
ROUTES

In this module, you can specify all known routes.

You should only focus on all the routes where both the **departing location** and the **arrival location** are known *[and created as locations in the locations module]*. This information will automatically be connected with your product screenings, enabling you to only input these transport routes once.

Why do we need to know your routes?

We need to know all the default routes between all your created locations, to calculate the transport emissions as accurately as possible in each screening, as well as enable you to identify emission hotspots throughout your logistic flow.



HOW SPECIFIED ROUTES WILL HELP YOU

- **Automatic adjustment:** Like in the locations module, you only need to input your routes once. As soon as the full journey from supplier to end-customers is mapped, the tool is able to automatically adjust your product screenings to this flow of goods.
- **Improved accuracy:** Your screenings reflect the actual flow of goods, giving more precise results.
- **Save time:** You only input the route once, and any updates can be made in a single place within the tool.

NOTE

In this module it is important to input all the routes that apply to your supply chain.

E.g. if a supplier is both sending some products to your warehouse and sometimes directly to a retail store, you need to create both routes here.

In the country shares you should apply %-proportions to each journey.
